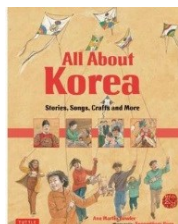

Age range: 9 - 11 yrs

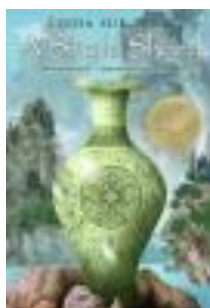

Age range: 10 - 14 yrs.

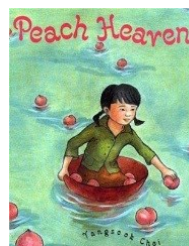
Intriguing text, informative sidebars, detailed maps and full-color photographs give readers a glimpse into Korea's geography, culture, people, government and daily life.

Age range: 11 - 15 yrs.

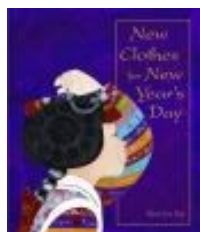

Age range: 5 - 7 yrs.

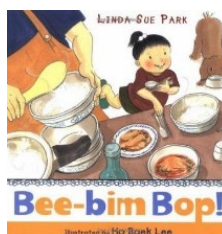
The Korean town where Yangsook lives is famous for wonderful peaches, but one year a heavy rainstorm threatens the crop.
